Every year:

- 1. Perform visual inspection
- 2. Check its operating within safe limits
- 3. Check relief valves
- 4. Check all valves leak tight
- 5. Check burst disc
- 6. Check exhaust ports
- 7. Check pressure gauge

Every five years:

- 1. All as above, as well as:
- 2. Replace regulator
- 3. Replace Burst Disc
- 4. Replace relief valves
